

GENERAL INFORMATION

STALL AVAILABILITY

Rolling Hills has reserved the park for Saturday, February 26, 2012. Stalls in Barns F, G, and H (the "back barns") will be available after 1:00 P.M. on Saturday. It is not known when stalls in all other barns (A thru E) will be available on Saturday. A stall chart will be posted at the park entrance and at the concession stand.

STALL RESERVATIONS AND BEDDING

For stall reservations and to order bedding, contact John Goda (770) 475-1244, godajohn@aol.com.

If you wish to have bedding delivered, stalls and bedding must be ordered by noon on the Friday preceding the show (preferably on your entry blank).

Bedding can be ordered at the show office on Sunday morning, in which case, it will have to be picked up by the exhibitor at the shavings stall or trailer.

ENTRIES

It is a major advantage to have your entries mailed or faxed to us no later than 12 o'clock noon on the Friday before the show. We understand that there may be changes and that is not a problem for us. We would like to assign as many exhibitor numbers and make as many entries onto the class sheets as possible before the office opens.

As changes are sometime necessary, we prefer that you plan on an open check for show expenses. With an open check, we can easily make refunds if it is necessary to scratch a class. Do not send open checks in the mail; just bring them to the show office on Sunday.

LATE ENTRIES

A \$10 **late** entry fee will be assessed to each horse for entries received after 12 o'clock noon on Friday, February 24, 2012.

OLDE MILTON GENERAL RULES

1. ACADEMY CLASSES are open to Saddleseat, Hunt Seat and Western Seat riders. Academy classes will be split if there are more than six entries.
2. Helmets will be allowed in any class without penalty.
3. COGGINS – A valid negative Coggins must be available to be shown to the show secretary.
4. All entry sheets must be signed by an authorized adult.
5. Olde Milton shows are sanctioned by ASHAG and GMHC.
6. RETURNED CHECKS – All checks returned for insufficient funds will be charged a \$50.00 handling fee.
7. BEDDING REQUIREMENT – All horse stalls must have a minimum of 2 bags of bedding. There will be a fine of \$35 for all horse stalls that do not meet this requirement. The fine is assessed by Wills Park and is determined by park personnel at various times of the day.

8. DECLINED ENTRIES – The management of Olde Milton reserves the right to decline or return any entry fee and/or stable fee before or during the horse show, without being liable for compensation. No entries will be accepted if there is an outstanding balance from a previous Olde Milton show.
9. HOLDS – There is a two minute limit on holds. Requests should be made at the show office or with the Paddock Master/Gate Master. Once the class is called, the gate will remain open for no more than two minutes.
10. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check in at the paddock with the Paddock Master.
11. With the exception of Academy Championships, qualifying is **not** required to enter a championship.
12. MANAGEMENT'S DECISION IS FINAL – Anyone entering the show grounds agrees to abide by the rules and decisions of the Olde Milton Horse Show Management.
